ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter came before the Personnel Resources Board, NANCY HOLLAND YOUNG, Chair, SUSAN MILLER, Vice-Chair, and VICKY BOWDISH, Member, for dismissal pursuant to WAC 357-52-215 and WAC 357-52-220.

On May 25, 2016, Ms. Reichelderfer filed an appeal.

By letter dated June 2, 2016, Board staff sent a letter of jurisdiction to both parties. The letter stated reasons why the board does not have jurisdiction over the appeal and directed the parties to submit affidavits and/or written argument within twenty-one (21) calendar days why the appeal should not be dismissed. Neither party responded to the letter.

The Notice of Potential Dismissal was sent on June 27, 2016, in accordance with WAC 357-52-035. The notice stated the appeal would be dismissed unless, within fifteen (15) calendar days following the date of the notice, the Board received a written request showing good cause why the appeal should not be dismissed. Neither party responded to the notice.

The parties failed to establish good cause why the appeal should not be dismissed. Therefore, the appeal should be dismissed.

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The Board having reviewed the file and records herein and being fully advised, now enters the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the appeal of Deborah Reichelderfer vs. the Department of Retirement Systems, PRB Case No. R-JUR-16-003, is dismissed.
